Life, Liberty and the Pursuit of Quilting

1. **Division 1 - Large Quilts** - Perimeter of 330" or larger

Category **A** Appliqué - Appliqué predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **B** Pieced - Piecing predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **C** Mixed/Other - Combination of appliqué, piecing and other techniques

2. **Division 2 - Medium Quilts** - Perimeter of 200- 329"

Category **D** Appliqué - Appliqué predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **E** Pieced - Piecing predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **F** Mixed/Other - Combination of appliqué, piecing and other techniques

3. **Division 3 - Small Quilts** - Perimeter of less than 200"

Category **G** Appliqué - Appliqué predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **H** Pieced - Piecing predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **I** Mixed/Other - Combination of appliqué, piecing and other techniques

4. **Division 4 - Wall Quilts** – Any quilt made to display on a wall, where no side measures more than 72"

Category **J** Appliqué - Appliqué predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **K** Pieced - Piecing predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **L** Art – An original design, made without a commercial pattern, an expression of your personal design

Category **M** Mixed/Other – Combination of appliqué, piecing and other techniques

5. **Division 5 - Group/Friendship Quilts** - Made by a group of 2-or more-includes quilts sent out for machine or hand quilting.

Category **N** Appliqué - Appliqué predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **O** Pieced - Piecing predominates, small amounts of other techniques allowed

Category **P** Mixed/Other - Combination of appliqué, piecing and other techniques

6. **Division 6 - Miniature Quilts** - Quilts with an overall pattern reflecting a reduced scale - Perimeter not to exceed 96"

Category **Q** Miniature

7. **Division 7 - Miscellaneous**-Must be 3 layers

Category **R** Pillows and other home accessories

Category **S** Clothing and other personal accessories

8. **Master**- Any quilter who has won a Best of Show or First place award in any AQS/NQS/IQA competition, someone who judges quilts, has written a book on quilt making, sells quilts, or practices quiltmaking as a profession.

Category **T** Master

9. **Non Judged – Exhibit Only**– Any quilt that needs not be judged. These quilts will be taken as space allows

Category **U** Non-judged

10. **Youth /School quilts- Exhibit only**-age 16 and under. All items will receive a participation ribbon. No Entry Fee.
